THE HIDDEN TREASURES OF MYSTICAL JHALAWAR

Garh Palace - The impressive palace built in 1838 by Maharaja Madan Singh & his successors. Beautiful paintings were latter on added inside some rooms. The **Govt. Museum** has also been shifted in this palace, which is one of the oldest museum of Rajasthan. It houses rare coins, paintings, manuscripts, statues and many more.

Bhawani Natyashala - Constructed in 1921 by Maharaja Bhawani Singh in the premises of Garh Palace. It was a popular Persian theater (Opera Style).

Ren Basera - This beautiful wooden house reassembled in 1936 by former Maharaja Rajendra Singh of Jhalawar. At present RTDC runs it as hotel, located on the banks of Krishna Sagar.

Sun Temple - A magnificent 10th century temple located in the heart of Jhalrapatan city. It is one of the best examples of temple architecture with lovely sculptures.

Shantinath Jain Temple - 11th Century Shantinath Jain temple, having beautiful carvings and sculptures.

Herbal Garden - Near to the Dwarkadhish temple, this garden comprises a wide variety of herbal medicinal plants developed by forest deptt. It is cool place suitable for all type of plants even in summer or winter.

Chandrabhaga Temple - This is a temple complex which has beautiful temples some dating as far back as the 7th century. Nearby is the Chandrabhaga river, where thousand of people have a holy dip during Chandrabhaga fair at full moon night.

Gagron Fort - The only water fort of Rajasthan, built in medieval period by Khinchi dynasty, surrounded with three sides by Ahu & Kalisindh river which provides a breathtaking view from its ramparts. Out side the fort is a dargah of sufi saint Mittheshah. At the sangam of rivers, there is the monastery of saint Pipa.

Budhist Caves and Stupas - The only known rock-cut buddhist caves in Rajasthan. The ancient caves are of great importance, both archaeologically and historically. These caves are located in the village Kolvi, Vinayka and Hathiyagod.

Jain Temple, Chandkheri - This Jain temple known for its architectural splendor & religious sanctity, was built in 17th Century. It has a six feet tall Lord Adinath statue in sitting position.

Jain Shwetamber Nageshwar Parshwanath Temple, Unhel - An important religious Jain pilgrim centre, having a thousand year old Parshwanath statue.

Dalhanpur - It stands on the banks of river Chhapi (Irrigation dam). A dense green forest adds to the charm of the antique place with beautifully carved pillars, torans and some erotic figures in the temple ruins, scattered over an area of 1 Km.
